rant Status... Early 2004 we applied for a grant to purchase hoses and sprinklers for the cemetery and funds to secure the door of the storage vault near the entry gate. We have received the promised funds from the State Parks and Historical Cemeteries Commission and we thank them for this opportunity.

#### Thanks to Milwaukie Pioneer Association Member, Pat DuVal...

Pat works for the City of Milwaukie. She recently spent time in the basement records vault at City Hall and unearthed some old cemetery records. The City has turned them over to the Association and your secretary is going through them now as time allows.

Included in the records are receipts for quite a number of plots for burials between 1920 and very early 1940. These will be interfiled with the burial permits we have and after copies are made, the records will be placed in the safe deposit box donated to Milwaukie Pioneer Cemetery Association by the Milwaukie branch of Bank of the West. Copies will be available at the Museum before too long.

The records she gave us do not appear to include the missing burial book (see related article) however, there do seem to be several lists of burials.

Information will be added to the data base as the records are gone through and it is hoped that we will have more complete lists available for viewing on Memorial Day. We intend to have the ability to look up and help visitors locate information by death year, plot and alphabetically by last name. There is never an end to a data base such as this, as new information is always coming along, but we will have as much completed as we can for folks to look at.
