Some time ago we began searching for the water meter that services the Cemetery, and lo, and behold it has finally been located, not under the paved bicycle path as was feared, but on the bank to the North of the entrance gate. Our thanks to **Mike Clark, Milwaukie Public Works Dept.**, and his city crew for unearthing the meter, setting concrete around it and making it possible to turn off the water should we have a pipe break in the cemetery any time in the future.

ALSO...

We had met with **John Alexander, Maintenance Supervisor at the Waverly Golf Course**, and he had agreed to have his crew address berries and over-growth on our fencing surrounding the cemetery. Work has progressed and the berries seem to be abated almost entirely. We anticipate much of the ivy and the encroaching trees will be addressed this Fall and Winter, and perhaps into this coming Spring.



The Board has agreed that we will begin exploring how to get electricity onto the grounds in the future. We are hoping we can have labor and materials donated or get at least a bargain price. The need for some form of power at the cemetery has become apparent over the Memorial Day weekends for a coffee pot and music for the flag ceremony, etc. and would also be beneficial for the use of electric power tools for clean-up days.

Possibility of Coming Events...

There is a possibility that SE 17th Ave. between Milwaukie and Portland's Sellwood Neighborhood will have sidewalks and bicycle lanes in the not-too-distant future.

The City of Milwaukie is in the process of applying for grant funds in order to connect the trails in Portland with the Riverfront Park/Trolley Trail in Milwaukie.

The Cemetery Board has written a letter in support of this project to ODOT and has also reminded those involved that we need to continue to have our driveway accessible and that we very much in need of safe parking along our frontage for visitors and those who participate in clean-up days.

With many entities chasing grant funding for improvement projects, we are hoping we have helped to make a strong enough case to make this happen.

Whether or not these project funds become available, we will be searching for ways to enhance our entrance and protect it from future erosion. To that end the Board is exploring different grant opportunities and other avenues which can help to accomplish this in the future.
