We wish to thank the families that supplied the top two for their patience as it took some time for the volunteers to muster to get the work done... hopefully it was worth the wait.

Even though weeds are merely misunderstood flowers...

we tried an organic method of weed control this year in the plots that have curbs and have, or have had, barkdust or other coverings.

Instead of just spreading the barkdust, as we have traditionally done in the past and with the Boy Scouts' help, this year we lined the ground with newspapers and then placed the bark dust on top of the newspapers. The paper will dissolve eventually but has worked pretty well in curbing those pesky weeds. We thank Kathy Neubauer for that suggestion and for, in general, overseeing the project.

Due to the cost of barkdust, and the hauling of same, we are not always able to place it, nor are we able to hit all of the enclosed plots every year. Some years it is quite a bit more expensive than other years, however, last year it seemed to be some cheaper than at other times, so we spread more than the normal amount and were able to cover more plots than we may have in years past. We'll see what this coming Spring brings as to the costs...
