The Secretary of State's Corporation Commission levies a fee/tax annually on all non-profit organizations of \$50, which is five (5) of our member's dues each year...

Please, now is the time to contact your legislative representative to have this fee either drastically reduced or done away with altogether.

Please site the following reasons why this tax is unfair to groups such as ours:


- 1. The expense takes valuable dollars (five membership dues annually!) away from our goals to maintain, preserve and restore our historical cemetery and from the good works of other non-profits;
- 2. Historical cemeteries serve as a huge and integral part of cities', towns' and rural areas' history and must be preserved; and
- 3. Since there are numerous people who travel around visiting old cemeteries as a part of their vacation or outing, historical sites such as pioneer cemeteries contribute in some measure to tourist dollars, even though that contribution may not be quantifiable.
