City of Milwaukie Proposes Big Changes to SE 17th Ave...

The City is proposing to install bike/pedestrian lanes on either side of SE 17th and the plan includes concrete sections of vegetation on the W side of 17th separating traffic and bikes, which, in effect leaves Milwaukie Pioneer with no parking on or near our frontage.

Keith Neubauer has agreed to follow up and try to work with the City on this issue so that we can maintain our current parking agreement with the City and accommodate our visitors into the future.
